Go to the calling frequency, 145.500MHz, and say:

“CQ CQ CQ . This is _____ (you)” *(Repeat a couple of times)*

After making contact with someone, say

“_____ (them), this is _____ (you). Please wait while I find a frequency”

Find a free channel, and after listening, call:

“This is _____ (you) – Is this frequency in use?”

If nothing is heard, go back to 145.500MHz and say:

“_____ (them), this is _____ (you). Please change frequency to _____”

Change to the free channel and say:

“_____ (them), this is _____ (you). Are you receiving?”

When the station has confirmed:

“_____ (them) this is _____ (you). My name is _____. Your Signal Report is _____. How do you copy? _____ (them), this is _____ (you).”

When you have finished:

“_____ (them), this is _____ (you). Thanks for the contact today. This is _____ (you) signing off.”
